DOUBT or DENIAL?

Jesus Appears to Thomas

²⁴Now Thomas, one of the Twelve, was not with the disciples when Jesus came. ²⁵So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe."

²⁶ A week later his disciples were in the house again, and Thomas was with them. Though the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" ²⁷ Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe."

²⁸ Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!"

²⁹ Then Jesus told him, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

Having devoted three years of his life to Jesus only to watch him suffer and die, Thomas was emotionally shattered. And when he heard from the other disciples that Jesus was alive again, it must have seemed like a cruel trick.

It's hard to say just what was going through his mind when he responded, "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe it" (20:25). Was he angry, defiantly refusing to believe? Afraid, not wanting to be hurt again? Honestly seeking the truth amid an impossibly miraculous series of events?

A week after Thomas said these words, Jesus appeared again to all the disciples, including Thomas. Jesus greeted them, then promptly invited Thomas to touch the very places on his body that Thomas had demanded to touch. Immediately Thomas responded with belief.

Reflecting on possible reasons for Thomas's early unbelief may lead us to ask ourselves a few questions: is our unbelief, unresolved anger at God for "causing" our pain? Is it a shield from further disappointment? An honest search for truth? Jesus promised Thomas that a special blessing awaited all those "who have not seen and yet believed" (20:29).

Not only freedom from addiction, but also emotional and physical restoration await the modern-day Thomas who will risk disappointment by reaching out to "touch" the Lord. Recovery will begin when we make a conscious decision to turn our lives (Thinking) and wills (Actions) over to Jesus Christ, trusting His resurrection power to help us with our lack of faith.

Keith surrendered and asked the Lord Jesus Christ into his life and accepted the Grace and Forgiveness and this stirred his heart to reach out and care for others.

Keith made great strides in his life and volunteered for Psalm 23 and eventually worked in the Ministry. Keith left Psalm 23 to pursue his higher education and went to University of the Fraser Valley to achieve his Counselling Degree and work towards his Masters.

In 2007, Keith was the first alum awarded with Psalm 23's Courageous Starfish Award. Keith not only displayed the courage to change his life but had such a transformation in being a father and son to his family. Keith also was instrumental to serving community in many facets while coming beside those who were hurting in their addictions and provided encouragement and support throughout his years.

Keith also had a passion to golf and would always have suggestions on how others could better their game...he loved to laugh and lift others up. Keith would always get excited when his brother and parents would get to go golfing together.

One day while golfing with Founder/Executive Director Marvin Declare at the 108 Golf Course, Keith saw this amazing double rainbow and he asked Marvin to take a picture as he stood under it. After the picture Keith said, "We should start a golf tournament to help support the Training Centre that helps so many".

After Keith passed in 2015, God placed the Memorial Golf Tournament on our hearts and put it in motion. The tournament is held in August of each year.

This legacy for Keith and his family will continue his tradition of giving back, changing lives and sharing the Love of Jesus Christ at Psalm 23 and community.
